All items must be curbside by 7am on this day, but no earlier than **SEVEN (7) DAYS** prior.

Items that **WILL NOT** Be Picked Up Are:

Vehicle Tires **Fluorescent Bulbs Bricks, Concrete, or Cement Blocks**

Large Auto Parts Paint or Stain Cans, Liquids of any type

Refrigerators (without a CFC sticker & door removed) If articles are placed at the curb **AFTER** your street has been picked up, the crews **WILL NOT** return to that street. Any remaining items should be removed from the curbside by 7am the following morning.

Refuse pick-up is for City of Hudson Residents only. A fine will be charged if rubbish from outside of the City




