

Maple Grove Cemetery

at the corner of North Maple Grove Avenue and Cadmus Road along the north edge of the City, is operated by the City and dates back to 1867, when the original City cemetery (in what is now Webster Park) became filled. Legible gravestones were reset in a memorial plot at Maple Grove Cemetery in 1961.

Sprawling over 30 acres of wooded land, this scenic Victorian cemetery also showcases a striking receiving vault constructed in 1884.




Old City Cemetery

is located in the southeastern part of the City of Hudson. It is now a part of Webster Park. It is also the location of the large HUDSON water tower, which is visible for several miles, and that is situated in the far southeastern corner of the park.

Known burials occurred here from 1836 through 1897.

Cemetery Lots

Cemetery Lots may be purchased at the Hudson City Office. Residents of the City of Hudson receive a discount on the pricing of lots as Maple Grove Cemetery receives funding from the City's Income Tax.

Burials

All burials are performed by the City of Hudson. A proper and approved vault must be used for all burials.

One lot can accommodate:

1 Full Burial + 3 Cremations or 6 Cremations

All burials require a 24-hour business day notice in order to have time to prepare the site.

Flowers & Decorations

Flowers may be placed in pots or urns above the ground and in-line with monuments and markers. The setting of individual containers, plants, or shrubs in the ground is prohibited.

Monuments & Foundations

Monuments and markers shall be placed under the direct supervision of the City of Hudson and only in the position designated by the City. Monuments and markers may be purchased from funeral homes, third-party retailers or online retailers.

Foundations are required for all monuments and markers. Foundations will be ordered by and placed under the direct supervision of the City of Hudson.

Seasonal Clean-Up

Seasonal Clean-Up begins on or after October 1st & April 1st. Items not removed prior to these dates will be discarded. New items may be placed approximately two weeks later.
