

## Nathan Rude Home

Sometime around 1876, Nathan Rude had this home on West Main Street built. It has a tower with curved glass windows and marble fireplaces from Italy, one of which is of black marble.

In the 1930's Mr. Fred Culver bought the house at auction from Mrs. Reed's estate intending to restore it, but later sold the home to the Z. Taylor Dulworth family and they removed the tower that was once on the right side of this house. It later became the home of the Richard Collins family. Mr. Collins conducted a real estate business from this home.
