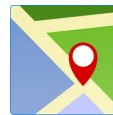
### GARAGE SALE PERMITS

Ordinance No. 381.08. Effective May 31, 2008

All garage, yard, basement, etc. sales must have a permit which will be posted in a conspicuous place at all times during the sale. Sales shall be limited to 3 per year and not more than 7 consecutive days each with a minimum of 30 days between the last day and the first day of any sale. Garage Sale permits are free. (This does not pertain to the city wide garage sale.)

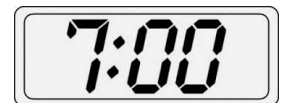

**CITY OF HUDSON  
CODE OF ORDINANCES  
SEC 12-206. CURFEW**



It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of 18 to be in public areas, or other unsupervised places in the City between the hours of 10:00 pm and 06:00 am the following morning, except of Friday and Saturday nights such prohibition for persons 16-17 years of age shall be 11:00pm and 6:00am the following morning.

This section does not apply to minors accompanied by a parent, guardian or another adult person having care and custody of the minor.

**SEC 12-123. STORAGE OF MATERIALS**

**Definitions(4)(a)(b) JUNK & JUNK VEHICLES**

Building materials, junk, trash, rubbish, remnants of wood, metal or any other cast off or debris of any kind, whether or not such materials could be put to any reasonable use.

**Junk Vehicle:** Any vehicle which is not licensed for use upon the highways of the State for a period in excess of ten days, and shall also include, whether licensed or not, any vehicle which is inoperative for any reason for a period in excess of ten days.
