




GARAGE SALE PERMITS

Ordinance No. 381.08. Effective May 31, 2008 All garage, yard, basement, etc. sales must have a permit which will be posted in a conspicuous place at all times during the sale. Sales shall be limited to 3 per year and not more than 7 consecutive days each with a minimum of 30 days between the last day and the first day of any sale. Garage Sale permits are *free*. This does not pertain to the city wide garage sales. Please call the City Office for information.

- Dogs should not be permitted to disturb the peace by frequent barking, howling, or yelping.
- Dogs are not permitted to discharge excrement • upon any private or public property.
- Dog owners must remove excrement from these • areas immediately upon discharge.
- Hudson has a **3 dog limit**. It shall be unlawful • to own or harbor more than 3 dogs, 6 months or older in the City limits.
