Spring Rubbish Pick-Up Saturday, April 14th

All items for general pick-up must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. on this day, but no earlier than **SEVEN (7) DAYS** before the pick-up date.

ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE PICKED UP ARE:

Vehicle Tires

Batteries

Fluorescent Bulbs

Large Auto Parts

Bricks, Concrete, or Cement Blocks

Paint or Stain Cans, Liquids of any type

Refrigerators (without a CFC sticker & door removed)

If articles are placed at the curb **after** your street has been picked up, the crews **will not** return to that street.

Any remaining items should be removed from the curbside by 7:00 a.m. the following morning.

Refuse pick-up is for City of Hudson Residents only. A fine will be charged if rubbish from outside of the City is found being brought into the City.

GARAGE SALE PERMITS

Ordinance No. 381.08. Effective May 31, 2008
All garage, yard, basement, etc. sales must have a permit which will be posted in a conspicuous place at all times during the sale. Sales shall be limited to 3 per year and not more than 7 consecutive days each with a minimum of 30 days between the last day and the first day of any sale. Garage Sale permits are *free*. This does not pertain to the city wide garage sales. Please call the City Office for information.

You may need a permit for your swimming pool.

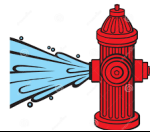
All Dogs

- Dogs are not allowed to run freely and must be secured.
- Dogs should not be permitted to disturb the peace by frequent barking, howling, or yelping.
- Dogs are not permitted to discharge excrement upon any private or public property.
- Dog owners must remove excrement from these areas immediately upon discharge.
- Hudson has a **3 dog limit**. It shall be unlawful to own or harbor more than 3 dogs, 6 months or older in the City limits.
